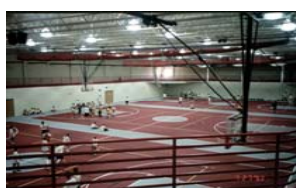
**Do you have aspirations of playing at the next level?

IWU COACHING STAFF

Greg Tonagel-Camp Director

Greg Tonagel became head coach at Indiana Wesleyan University in 2005 and has quickly taken the Wildcats to the top of the Mid-Central College Conference (MCC).

Tonagel took over a ball club that finished last in the conference and in four years has won 99 games and led the Wildcats to two NAIA Elite Eights and an NCCAA National Championship.

In only his second year, Tonagel coached the Wildcats to a record-breaking season which included most wins in a season (30), most conference wins in a season (14), the first ever IWU men's basketball conference championship, and first ever IWU men's basketball appearance in the NAIA Division II National Tournament—where the Wildcats advanced to the Elite 8.



This past season, the Wildcats had the 2nd most successful season in IWU history, winning 29 games and once again winning conference and advancing to the Elite 8. Tonagel has twice been named MCC coach of the year for his efforts.

Tonagel played college basketball at Valparaiso University, where he was a four-year starter and team captain for two years. While at Valpo, Tonagel played in 4 NCAA tournaments.

IWU COACHING STAFF



Jeff Clark just completed his third season on staff at IWU. Clark focuses on post player development as well as serving as the recruiting coordinator. Clark has been named the top assistant in the NAIA in each of the past two seasons by Indiana Basketball News. Clark was a four year letter winner at Anderson University where he was a two year captain and three year Academic All Conference performer. He has extensive camp experience, including serving as a counselor at the famous Five-Star Basketball Camp.



Fred Hodson just completed his second season on staff at IWU. Hodson, a former Wildcat player, is no stranger to Grant County basketball. During his IWU career, Hodson scored 1,856 points, which places him 5th on the all-time scoring list. He has also served time coaching at local schools such as Lakeview Christian and Mississinewa. On top of his stint at IWU, Hodson has over 14 years of coaching experience at the varsity level. He also has served as an individual instructor for local youth for over 20 years. Hodson has been employed as an elementary P.E. teacher for 16 years.

Wildcat Players-Each camp will include instruction from members of the NAIA Elite 8 team. This will include All-Conference and All-American performers. IWU players will instruct individual stations and coach a team in 5 on 5 league play.
